

### ***I was not willing and capable of signing a valid contract***

BC law says the VSA does not have the authority to help in contract disputes. For example, the VSA cannot help where you were willing and capable to sign a contract. Willing and capable means:

- You had the chance to review and understand the contract
- You signed the contract voluntarily

All adults are assumed willing and capable of signing a valid contract. This may not be the case in some special situations. These situations include:

- You didn't understand the contract because of a mental health issue.
- You signed the contract under duress. Duress means acting under threat or pressure.
